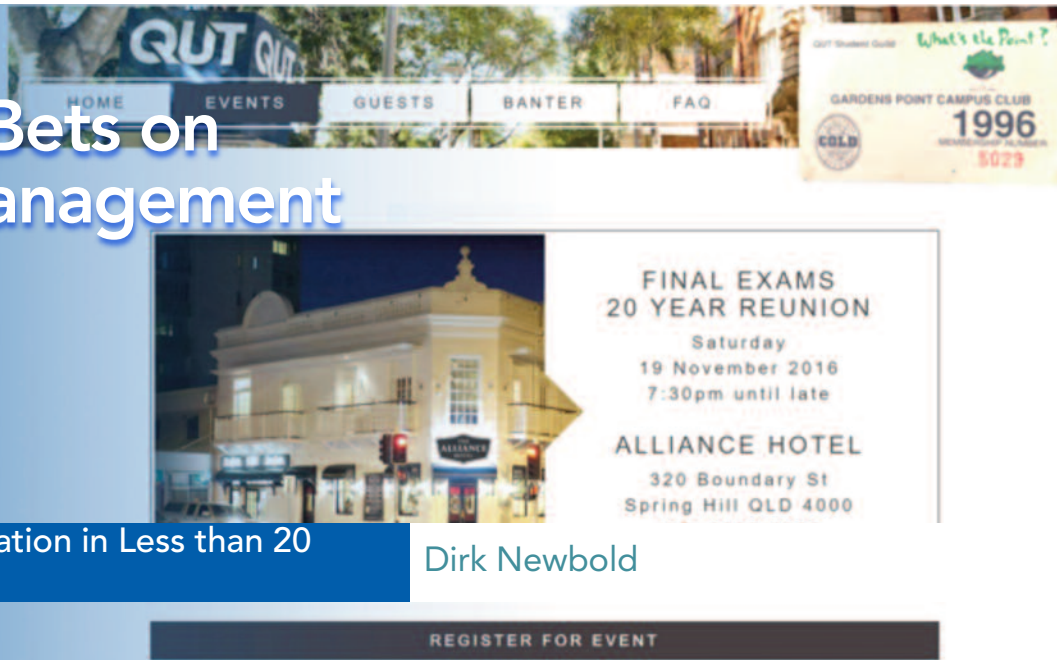


Web Start-Up Bets on RSVP Event-Management Package
