EBC Informatique's TotalHorizon is an integrated solution targeted to commercial sectors with a manufacturing component, such as supermarket suppliers and textile and mail-order companies. The solution is multilingual, multicurrency and multicompany or multibranch. Cincom's long history and direct experience in these specific industries, plus its language and currency transparency, are major factors in its ability to meet the needs of EBC Informatique and its customers.

"For EBC Informatique, Cincom provides an efficient means of quickly enhancing TotalHorizon, as is clearly demonstrated by the initial prototypes we have developed together," according to EBC Informatique project manager.

The project manager said that two essential TotalHorizon features are highlighted when selling the product: innovative technology (PC-based, object-oriented, integrated office automation, etc.), and the EBC Informatique methodology, which guarantees that all expressed needs can be met, combined with the flexibility of a solution built up around a true business framework. This ensures that the product can be offered at the best possible price with quick implementation taking between three and six months. Finally, the solution can easily evolve to keep pace with subsequent changes within the customer's company. All these features are grounded in the Cincom Smalltalk environment used for TotalHorizon development.

Extra Added-Value

Cincom ObjectStudio provides access to the leading commercial RDBMSs and enables the product architecture to be structured around reusable components, making permanent adaptation of the solution simpler for customers. For example, the user interface can be modified without compromising the rest of the application, while other components available from Cincom (Workflow and Distributed Communications FrameWork) can be added with ease.

"Smalltalk and ObjectStudio are ideally suited to management problems and have enabled us to build a true small-business framework which we can reutilize and tailor for each new customer context," the project manager said.

Recent Developments

Further increasing TotalHorizon's value to customers, EBC Informatique used the Cincom Smalltalk environment to develop means of integrating workflow automation for buying, making it possible for customers to adapt TotalHorizon to their own management methods. Another project involved integrating Cincom's Distributed Communications FrameWork (DCF) for Java and Smalltalk, and incorporating internet access into the solution to expand e-commerce capabilities. The resulting benefits made TotalHorizon even more attractive to its current and potential customers.

"DCF for Java enabled us to add Internet access capability to TotalHorizon," the project manager recalled. "And DCF for Smalltalk offers greater flexibility when distributing objects between clients and servers, in particular, for creating an application server separate from the presentation layer and the data server. With Cincom, we can now completely separate the various components of the application. Based on our experience with these projects, we can see what 'powered by ObjectStudio' really means."
